## GENERAL OBJECTIVE OF THE IMPACT-SC5:

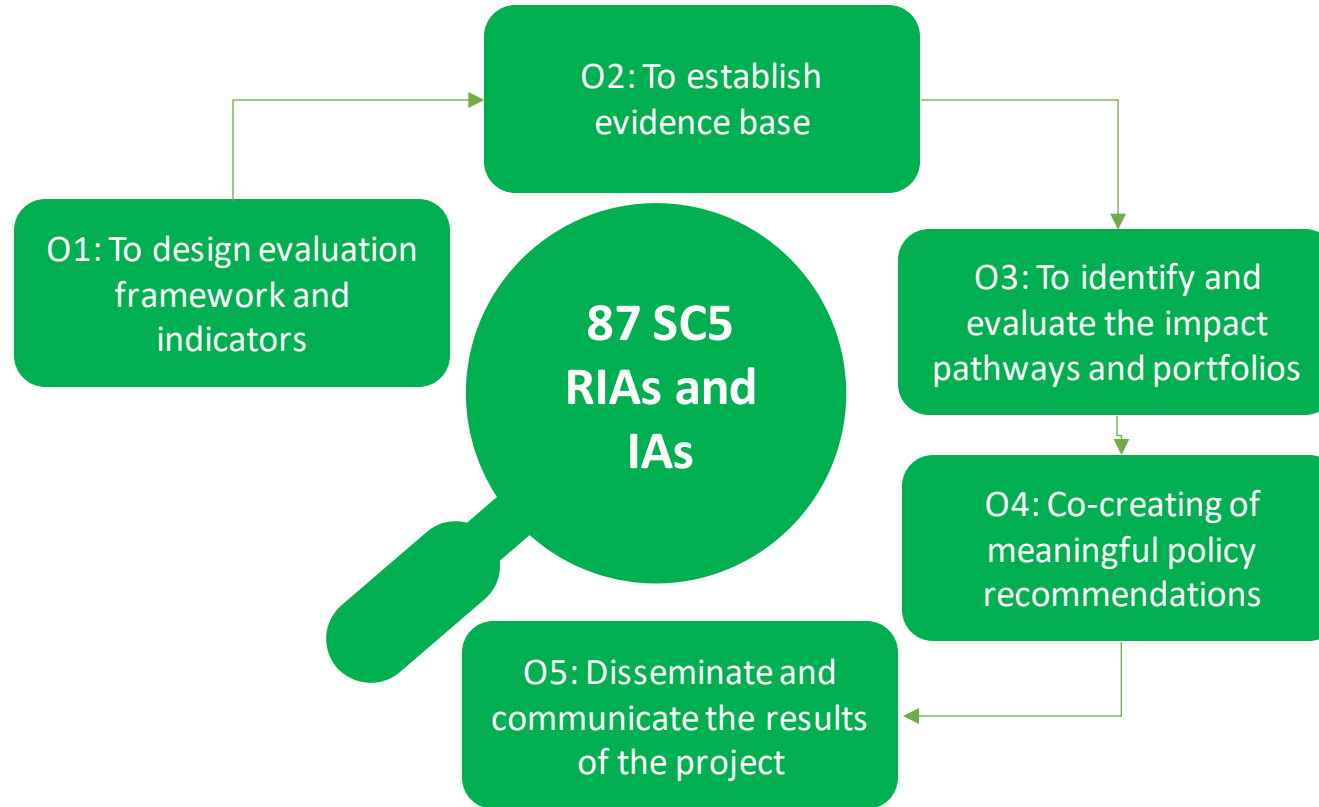
To **review the impacts** of the projects granted under Horizon 2020 Societal Challenge 5 (SC5) as described in its Work Programmes and Calls.

  - **Scientific**
  - **Environmental and societal**
  - **Economic**
